In terms of fundraising, since 1998 Quesnel Women's Fall Challenge has proudly supported the GR Baker Memorial Hospital's Mammography Unit.

- 1998** \$600 for miscellaneous equipment
- 1999** \$2000 towards redecoration of mammography unit
- 2000–2002** \$23,500 was donated towards the purchase of a high transmission cellular grid for the existing mammography machine (purchased in 2003)
- 2003** \$10,000 was donated towards the purchase of window treatments, 2 lazy-boy chairs and a TV stand for the chemotherapy treatment room, day care unit.

For the Mammo Unit: 4 Milex breast models, Maxant mammo techline illuminator, 2 Kodak cassette/screens, contour wedge, digital thermometer, Techno-aide mammo screening set
- 2004–2005** Mammography tops, picture frames, educational tools with the remainder in trust for the purchase of the digital mammography reading machine.
- 2006** Phantom and Denstometer (Mammography Equipment) and the remainder in trust for the purchase of the digital mammography reading machine
- 2007** \$13,000.00 added to the trust fund for the purchase of the digital mammography reading machine
- 2008** A further \$13,000 was added to the trust fund. As well, some supplies were purchased for the Mammography unit.
